Sharmila Gunasingham is a corporate lawyer involved in international practice. A daughter of a distinguished diplomat, Sharmila Gunasingham, a Singaporean by birth and nationality, was raised in the Western capitals of the world, including Washington D.C. and Bonn. Sharmila schooled in the UK and attended London University, working with a London law firm before returning to Singapore, where she made her home.

Admitted as a Solicitor of the Supreme Court of England and Wales in April 1981 and as an Advocate and Solicitor in Singapore in November 1981, she immediately began work with a large established law firm in Singapore. In a span of just four years, she became a corporate partner in a leading law firm.

After a decade, she was invited to co-found a new corporate law firm by a very senior and reputed Singapore corporate lawyer. The new firm became a highly rated corporate law firm during Sharmila's tenure as its Managing Director and she spearheaded the firm's Formal Law Alliance with Herbert Smith, a "magic circle" London law firm with international offices. Also during this time, Sharmila was appointed the Singapore representative of the leading Canadian law firm Stikeman Elliott.

In 2006, Sharmila founded her own firm, Global Law Alliance LLC, a Singapore law corporation. She set about extending her firm's capabilities and network beyond Singapore's borders to make GLA a global law firm.
